The award is open to all faculty, staff and students of the University of St. Thomas.

### Nomination and Award Process

Nominations are accepted from any St. Thomas faculty, staff, student, or alumni. The International Programs staff is comprised of the offices of International Education, Office of International Student Services and ELS Language Centers, will select a candidate or candidates from the nominations submitted.

The presentation of the award(s) will be made at the St. Thomas International Dinner that takes place on **April 16, 2011**. Recipient will be notified of award by letter, and will receive two tickets to attend the St. Thomas International Dinner. At the dinner they will receive:

- Certificate
- A desktop award globe

### Nomination Criteria

Deadline for nominations is **March 11, 2011**. - Connections made between the University of St. Thomas community and the world.
- International Programs staff members are excluded from receiving the award.
